What you should bring to the hospital for your delivery:

- Music, movies, book for possible long labor. You may want to create a song list.
- Camera, phone, computer and chargers
- Have email address list ready to notify arrival or your little one.
- Toiletries for mom and dad.
- Chapstick for mom because your lips may get dry when pushing.
- Robe and slippers. You can bring PJ's or comfy lounge wear but most patients wear the hospital gowns.
- Something comfortable for you and the baby to wear home.
- Make sure to purchase and install your infant car seat prior to your admission to the hospital.
- Snacks for dad or significant other.

If breast feeding bring:

- Lanolin cream for sore nipples
- Your breast pump if you have purchased one. You do not need to purchase a pump prior to delivery and can rent one from lactation in the hospital if needed.
- Nursing bra or tank top
